These tours follow successful tours run in 2018 and 2019.

2019 NYC Tour participant Zara Ismail said the tour enriched her “understanding of the role of UN and the huge impact it has on member states. I left the tour feeling empowered and motivated to contribute to the greater good of humanity. Not only that, I forged great friendships along the way. I am thankful to have been part of the Study Tour.”

The UNAA’s core mandate is to inform, inspire and engage all Australians regarding the work, goals, and values of the United Nations.

For interested participants, this is an opportunity to engage with Australia’s representatives to the UN, with UN Departments and agencies and international organisations headquartered in the two cities.

New York City is the home of UN Headquarters. The Office of the Secretary General is situated in NYC, along with a range of UN Departments and agencies. The General Assembly and Security Council are also located in New York.

22 - 28 OCTOBER

Two thirds of the activities of the United Nations system take place in Geneva, making it a key centre of international co-operation and multilateral negotiation. This is one of the reasons that the city is often referred to as "International Geneva". The UN Human Rights Council is also located in Geneva.

\$7500 each tour - this cost is paid by each participant.

The tour cost includes four star accommodation in the centre of Geneva and New York; group welcome and farewell dinners; all breakfasts; all tours and meetings and transportation in Geneva.
